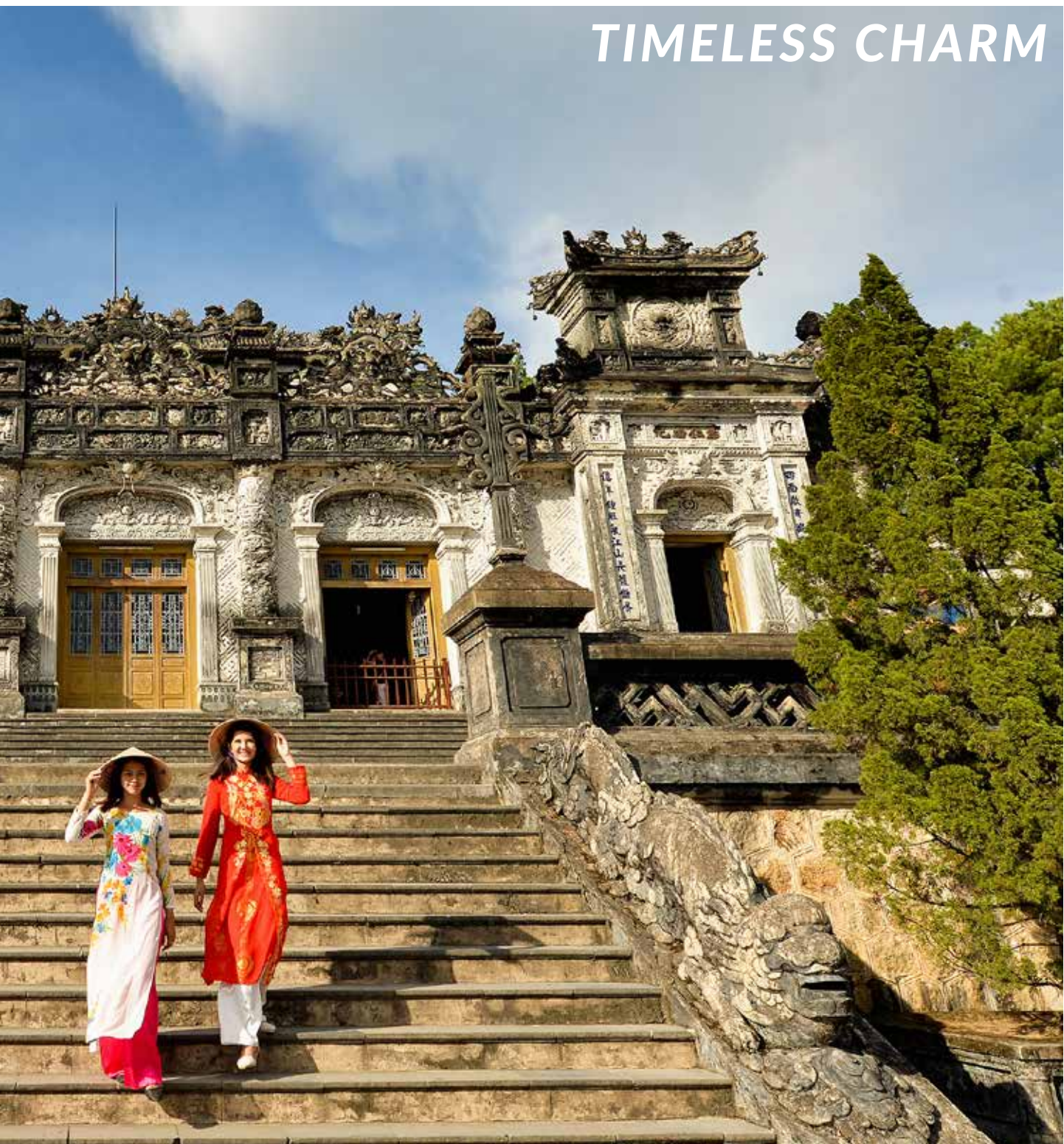

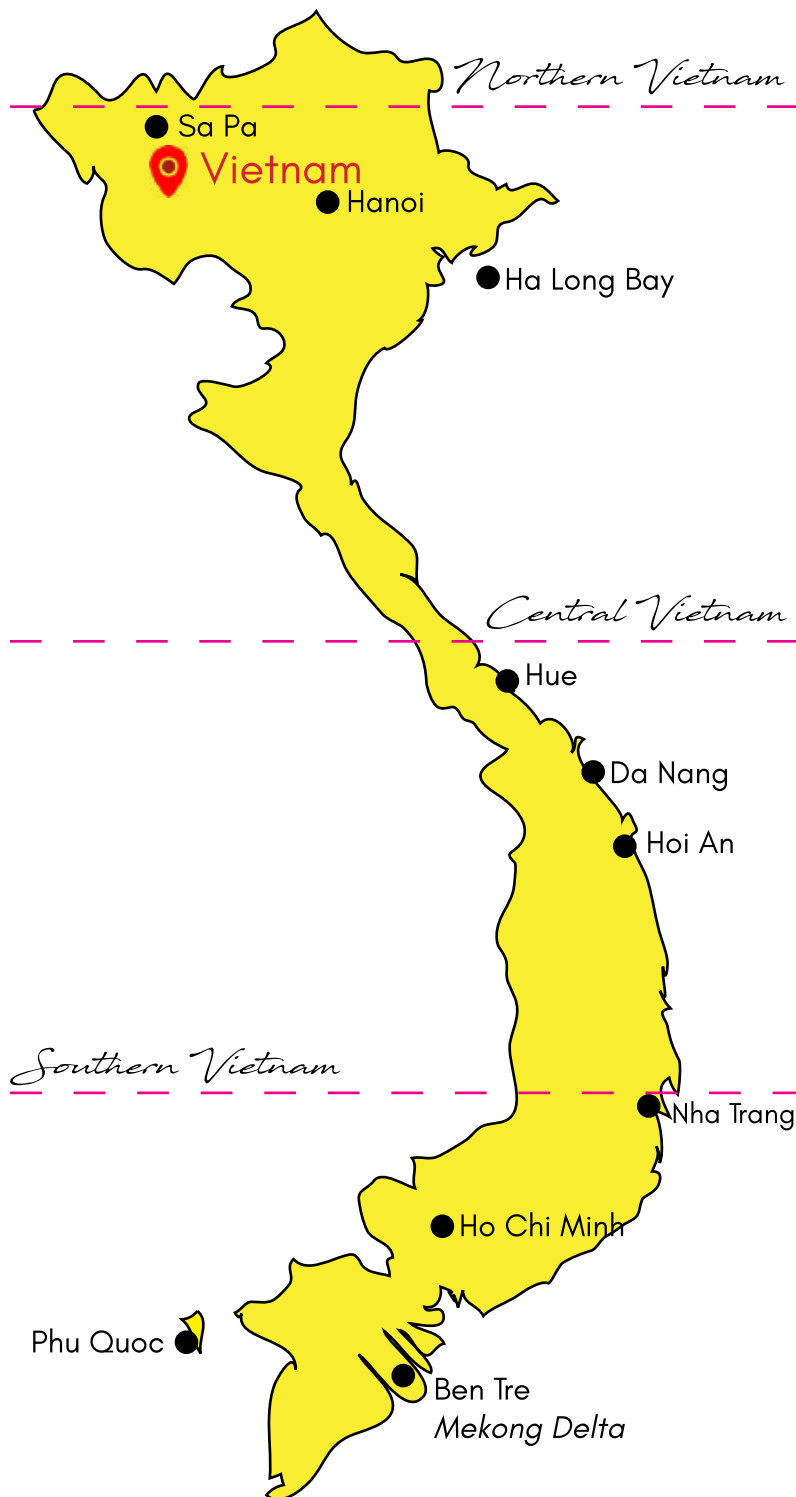
Discover **VIETNAM**
