# SABAH

Sabah the 'land below the wind' is located on the island of Borneo, alongside Sarawak, Brunei and Kalimantan in Indonesia. Surrounded by the South China Sea in the west, Sulu Sea in the northeast and Celebes Sea in the southeast, making it a place bountifully blessed with an amazing nature and wildlife, gorgeous beaches, and a diverse marine life.

Sabah is perhaps best known as home to the iconic Mount Kinabalu—the highest peak in Southeast Asia. Sabah is also home to some of the lushest jungles on Borneo, such as Danum Valley and Maliau Basin—the Lost World of Borneo.

Many wildlife species like the orangutan, the proboscis monkey, and the Bornean pygmy elephant, as well as plenty of endemic birds are also found in Sabah. Adding to its gorgeous natural splendour, Sabah presents warm hospitality unlike anywhere else in the world. It is a melting pot of more than 30 ethnic groups, which offers a wide range of cultural and traditional experiences, exotic cuisines, arts, and crafts.





## WILDLIFE

Sandakan is home to the famous Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre as well as the Kinabatangan floodplain, which is famous for the high density of Borneo's most emblematic birdlife and mammals, such as hornbills, the Bornean pygmy elephants, orang utans and proboscis monkey. A wildlife cruise along the Kinabatangan River will provide you with the opportunity to see endemic Bornean birdlife and wildlife in its natural habitat. Kinabatangan is a must-go place when in Sandakan.









The award-winning **Sukau Rainforest Lodge** offers you the best of nature and wildlife adventure, whilst offering an eco-friendly accommodation with great modern services and facilities. Wake up to the sounds of birds singing and sounds of wildlife that you will never hear in the city! ## **BEACH**

Other than its riches in jungle and wildlife, Sandakan also holds precious island gems in the beautiful Lankayan Island and Selingan Island. A world-renowned dive paradise and honeymoon destination, Lankayan offers a serene island experience surrounded by an endless view of azure blue waters and sparkling white sands. Also, don't miss a chance to witness turtles laying eggs on the beach during specific times of the year. It's simply magical!









Lankayan, a tiny jewel-shaped island located on the northeastern coast of Sabah, is part of the Sugud Islands Marine Conservation Area (SIMCA) and is surrounded blue-green waters and coral reefs. The *Lankayan Island Resort* makes a perfect honeymooner paradise, complete with a breath taking sunset view that spells romance with a capital R.








# The Danum Valley Conservation Area **Lahad Datu** Lahad Datu is located in the Tawau division, occupying the peninsula on the north side of Darvel Bay. A haven for naturalists, Lahad Datu is the gateway to Danum Valley Conservation Area, Tabin Wildlife Reserve, and Madai Caves. These rainforests also house some of the world's oldest, tallest and most diverse jungle trees, making it an enchanting destination for nature lovers.

#### **Tabin Wildlife Reserve**













Enveloped within a 120, 500-hectare dipterocarp rainforest, Tabin Wildlife Reserve is home to various endangered wildlife, such as the Bornean Pygmy elephant, Sumatran rhino, Tembadau and exotic birdlife. Wildlife photography and birdwatching enthusiasts will find Tabin a true nature paradise. Whether you're an adventure seeker, an environmentalist earth mother, a photography lover, an animal activist, or simply just someone looking out for something fun; Tabin extends her arms in welcome.

**DAY 2:** Early morning birdwalk before breakfast. Spend the whole day exploring the forest for birds and mammals, leading up to an escarpment with ancient burial coffins. Trek to waterfall for a refreshing dip in rock pools. Explore more trails leading to canopy walkway.

**DAY 3:** Morning trek in search of mammals and birds. Return to the Lodge before departing for Lahad Datu.




## **SARAWAK**

Sarawak, the 'land of the hornbills', is the largest state in Malaysia, and one of two Malaysian states on the island of Borneo. Sarawak borders to the other Malaysian state of Sabah, as well as Brunei and Indonesian, Kalimantan. Sarawak is blessed with an extraordinary mix of ethnicities, the largest one being the Iban people. Other local ethnic groups in Sarawak are the Bidayuh Melanau, Kenyah, Kayang, and Orang Ulu peoples.

Sarawak is famous for its beautiful national parks, most famous is probably the UNESCO heritage site of Mulu National Park, where some of the world's largest limestone caves are found. Other sites are Batang Ai and Baku National Parks, which are part of the region's largest trans-national protected area for tropical rainforest conservation.


Sarawak is also home to numerous species of wildlife, such as the famed rhinoceros' hornbill, which is the state's National Bird and in Kuching the orangutan rehabilitation centre.

Experience Sarawak in half a day. Set on a sprawling 17-acre site, this unique award-winning living museum offers visitors an excellent introduction to local cultures and lifestyles. Bako National Park is one of the most beautiful parks in Malaysia. For nature lovers, this park offers an aproboscis monkey, silver leaf monkey and longtailed macaque, as well as numerous species of birds and displays a wide variety of endemic Bornean floras like the carnivorous pitcher plants and wild orchids.






Cycling to capture the sights, sounds and smell of this compact city. The best way to explore whilst navigating through traffic and stopping at any attractions which you are interested in visit on the 3.5 hours ride. This tour ends with boat crossing across Sarawak River on a traditional water taxi















Enjoy adventure through the mangrovelined rivers for a wildlife-spotting adventure. As it gets darker, you will be able to see the adorable Proboscis monkeys hanging out on treetops. Keep an eye out for crocodiles too, crawling on the mud banks or swimming in the calm waters.







A sanctuary Sarawak's protected wildlife, mainly the Orang Utans. The entire facility occupies an area of 740 acres — the only remaining green belt near the city which acts as a sanctuary for orang utans. This rehabilitation centre serves as a temporary home for young orphaned primates and displaced orang utans rescued from captivity.







Experience the rainforest and stay at Nanga Sumpa Lodge. The local communities have a vibrant living culture with a fascinating history - the area is also home to the most significant population of orangutan in Sarawak. A tour to Ulu Ai offer a less intrusive way to meet the locals while appreciating the beauty of the environment.






### **REDANG ISLAND**
